Sheryl was Facebook's ambassador to the small business community, stepping up their efforts during the COVID pandemic to provide \$100 million in grants to small businesses and \$100 million in grants to Black businesses, nonprofits, and creators.

In addition to helping build the company, Sheryl implemented industry-defining benefits and programs to make the workplace more inclusive. She championed the use of Facebook to help people raise funds for nonprofits, increase organ donations, and share alerts on missing children. She also led efforts to expand paid family leave, bereavement leave, and domestic violence leave at Meta, sparking other major companies to implement similar policies.

Before joining the company then called Facebook, Sheryl was vice president of global online sales and operations at Google, chief of staff for the United States Treasury Department under President Clinton, a management consultant with McKinsey & Company, and an economist with the World Bank. She continues to serve on Meta's board of directors and also serves on the boards of Momentive, ONE Campaign, and Women for Women International.
