Newport News Shipbuilding, a division of HII, is partnering with the Virginia Ship Repair Association (VSRA) and several local community colleges to offer **several course-to-hire Marine Trainee** programs for individuals interested in full-time trades careers with NNS. These 2-3 week courses equip individuals with the skills necessary to begin a trades career at Newport News Shipbuilding.

BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

- 18 years or age or older
- U.S. Citizen
- Ability to work **any** shift
- Pass a background check, drug screen, and physical

ALL COURSES:

- Occur Monthly
- Monday-Friday 7 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- 90% hands-on instruction
- Resulting in a full-time job with NNS upon graduating!

DECK ELECTRICIAN

Deck Electricians work on many electrical systems aboard a ship including lighting, power distribution, communications or navigation.
Offered at Virginia Peninsula Community College.

MARINE COATINGS/PAINTER

Marine painters perform solvent, hand tool and power tool cleaning and apply paint using various brushes and rollers to the standards required in a marine environment.
Offered at Tidewater Community College.

PIPEFITTER

Responsible for installing complex systems together on the ship and in the shop. More than 230 miles of pipe are installed on an aircraft carrier.
Offered at Tidewater Community College.

SHIPFITTER

Often called the "carpenters" of shipbuilding, or "Artists of Steel", shipfitters measure, cut, grind, fit, align, and tack weld parts to the structural body of the ship.
Offered at: Camp Community College, Tidewater Community College, and Virginia Peninsula Community College.

MACHINIST

Inside and Outside Machinists are responsible for the installation, repair and overhaul of naval ship's mechanical components and systems.
Offered at Camp Community College.

MARINE INSULATOR

Insulators remove, repair, and install various types of insulation.
Offered at QED Systems in Norfolk, VA. Not a VSRA program.

SHEET METAL WORKER

Responsible for fabricating and assembling a variety of components onboard ships such as ventilation, joiner bulkheads, framing, furniture, cabinetry, lockers and foundations.
Offered at Tidewater Community College.

WELDER

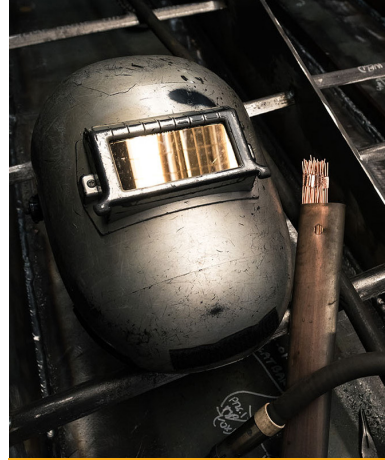
Welders use a wide range of filler metals and welding processes to perform structural and pipe welds in all phases of production on aircraft carriers and submarines.
Offered at Camp Community College, Tidewater Community College, and Virginia Peninsula Community College.

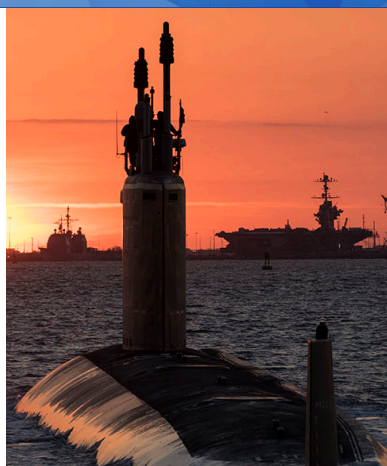

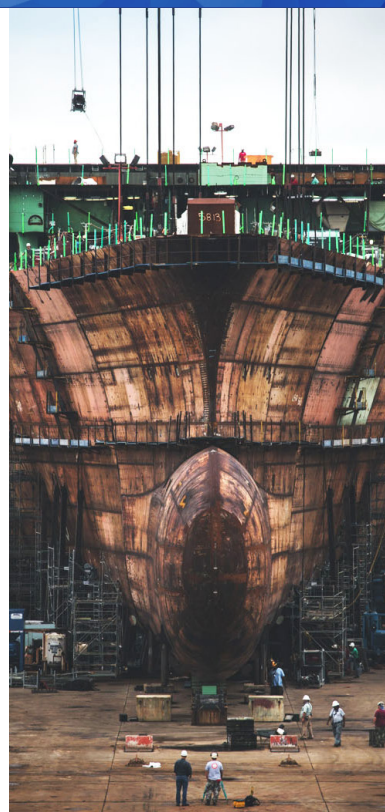
