Terms and Conditions for COTS Orders Below the MPT Including FAR and DFARS Clauses applicable to Commercial Products or Services

By accepting an Order from HII Mission Technologies below the Micro Purchase Threshold (MPT), for Commercial Off the Shelf (COTS) products or services, The Parties agree to the following minimal terms:

For P-Card Orders: Seller's standard published commercial terms of Sale shall apply to the Order. In the absence of Seller published terms of sale, HII Mission Technologies' Standard PO Terms and Conditions shall apply.

For Purchase Orders: HII Mission Technologies Standard PO terms and Conditions shall apply to the Order by reference.

In addition to the Terms and Conditions outlined above, the following U.S. Government Terms or Clauses in FAR Subpart 52.2 and DFARS Subpart 252.2 are incorporated into the Order with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text), Where appropriate, "Government" or "Contracting Officer" shall mean "Buyer," and "Contractor" shall mean "Seller." The terms "Government" or "Contracting Officer" do not change: (i) when a right, act, authorization, or obligation can be granted or performed only the Government, (ii) when access to proprietary financial information or other proprietary data is required, (iii) when title to property is to be transferred directly to Government.

In the event of a conflict, these U.S. Government Terms shall take precedence. To the extent that the prime contract or higher-tier subcontract under which this Order is issued is modified (to include a newer version of any such clause), the date of the modified version of the clause as it appears in such prime contract or higher tier subcontract shall be controlling and said version shall be incorporated herein.
