After retiring from active duty—and prior to joining HII in 2024—he also served as a senior consultant at Ventus Solutions, supporting classified maritime programs for DARPA.

Rogeness earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering technology from Prairie View A&M University and a master's degree in education from Iowa State University. He also completed Command Leadership School at the U.S. Naval War College and holds two certifications from Defense Institute of Security Assistance Management.
