



# Stephen Schwedhelm

## Portfolio Leader, All-Domain Operations Mission Technologies

Steve Schwedhelm is a portfolio lead in the All-Domain Operations group in Hill's Mission Technologies division. He is responsible for leading a portfolio of 70 projects delivering cutting-edge intelligence and C5ISR (command, control, communications, computers, cyber, intelligence, surveillance, reconnaissance and targeting) solutions, supporting the critical missions of the Department of Defense and Department of Homeland Security.

Following his military career, he worked at MAG Aerospace, supporting advanced aviation assessment programs that directly supported Army Special Operations aviation technology development and sustainment efforts.

Schwedhelm earned a bachelor's degree in aerospace engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and a master's degree in global leadership from the University of San Diego's Knauss School of Business. He also earned a Project Management Professional certificate from the Project Management Institute and Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act certifications in program management, engineering and technical management, and life-cycle logistics.
